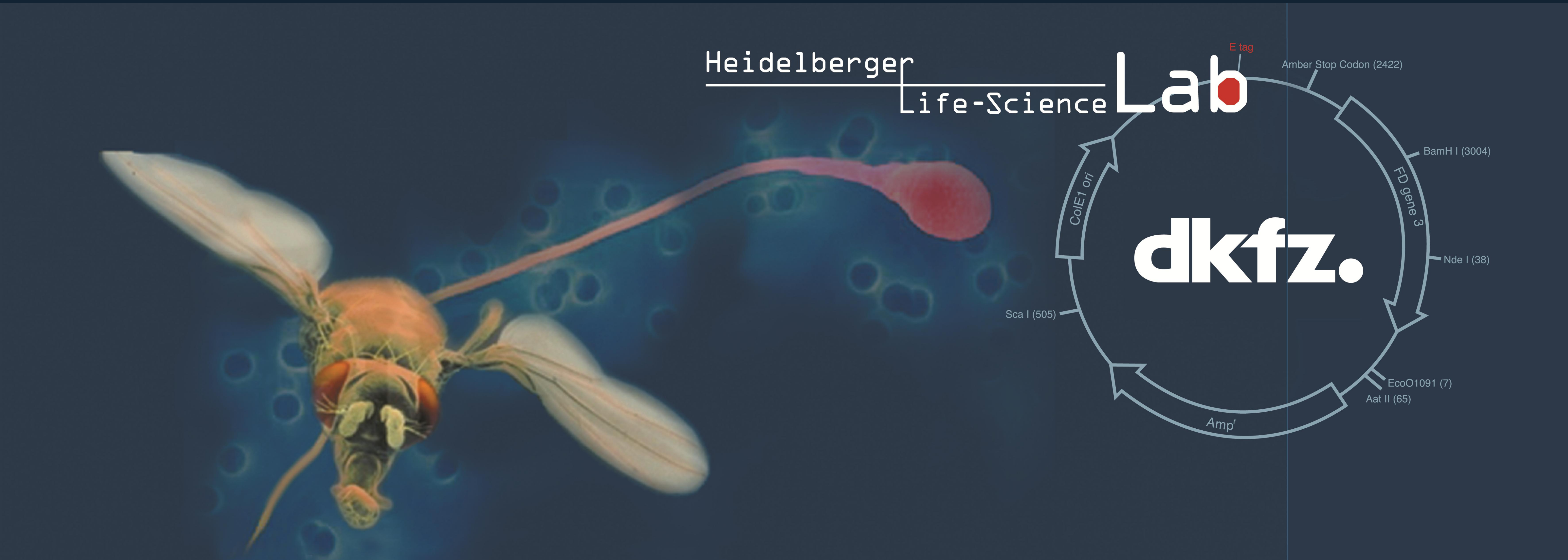




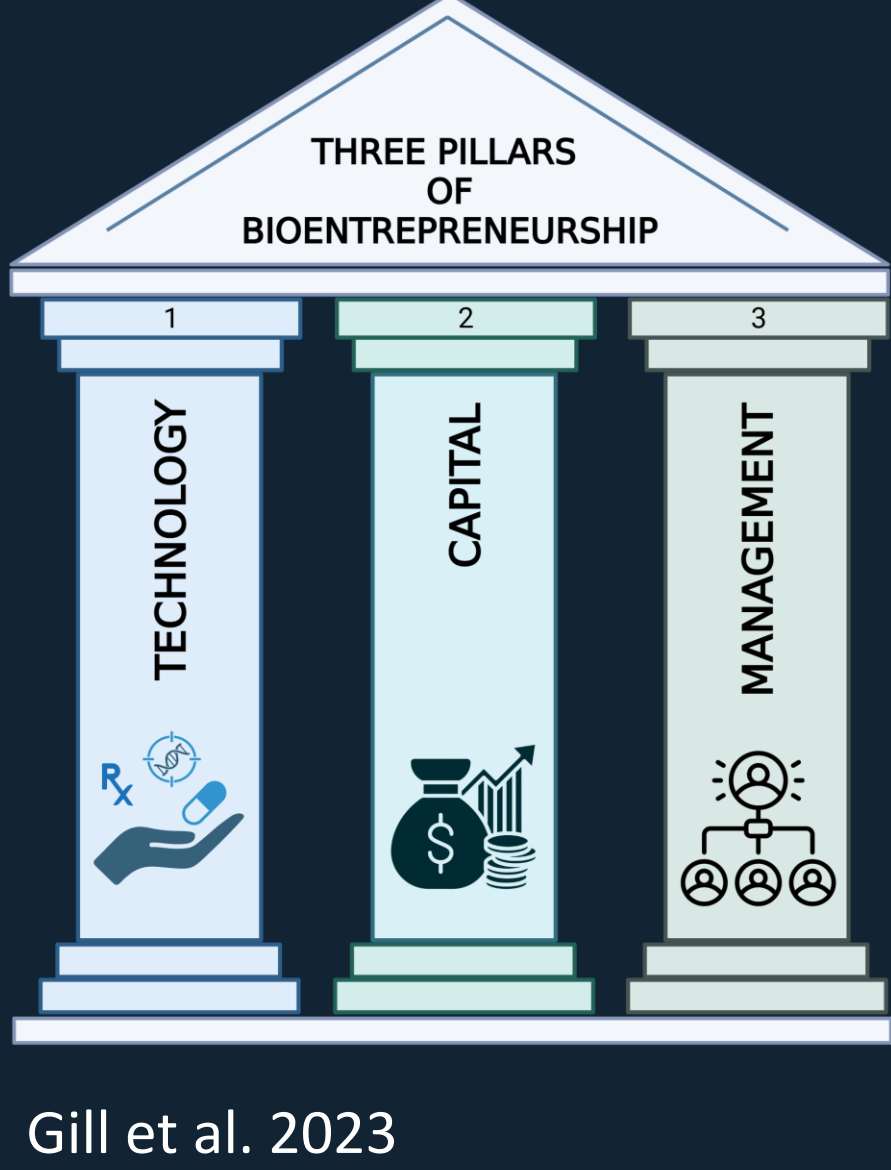
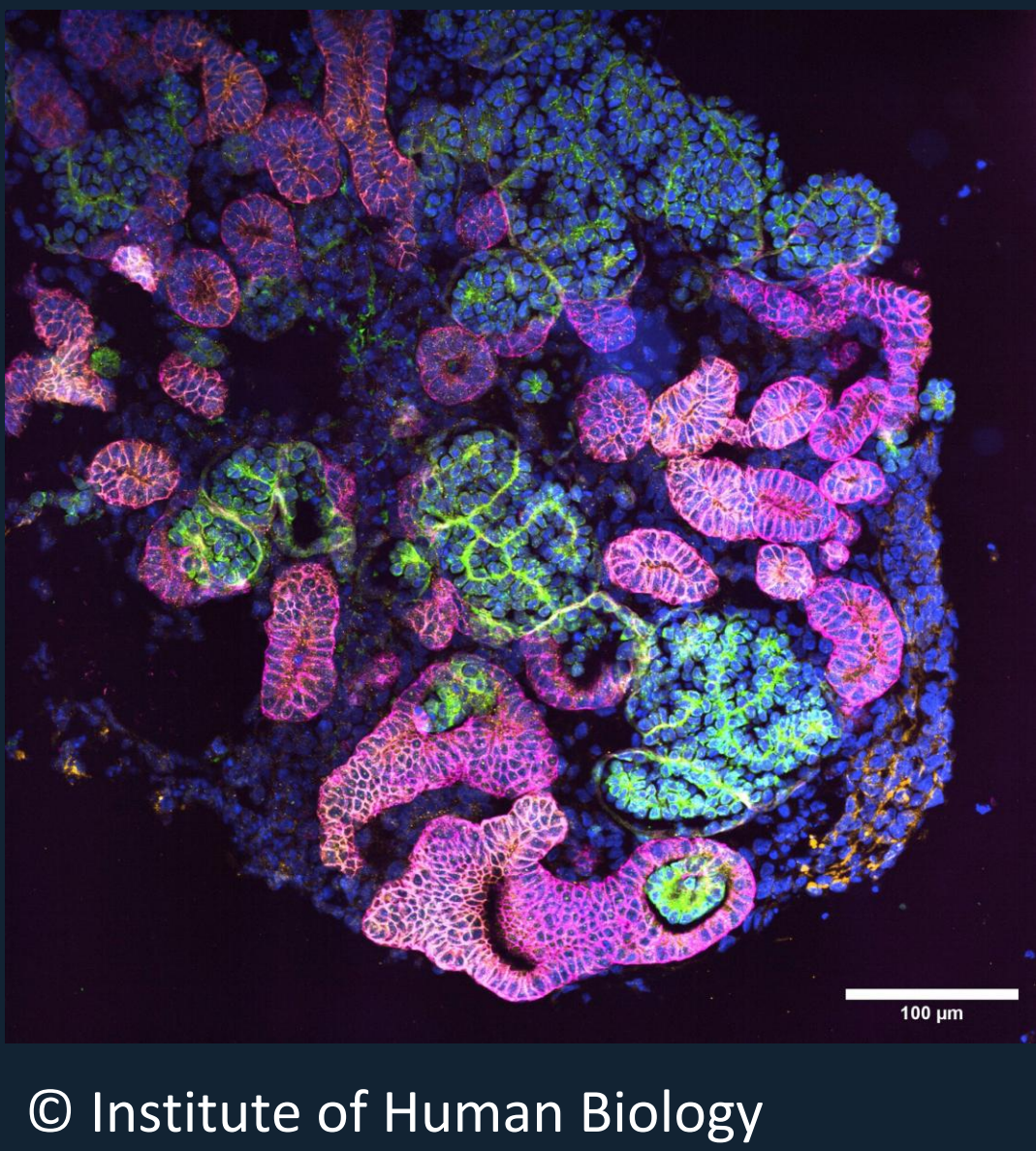
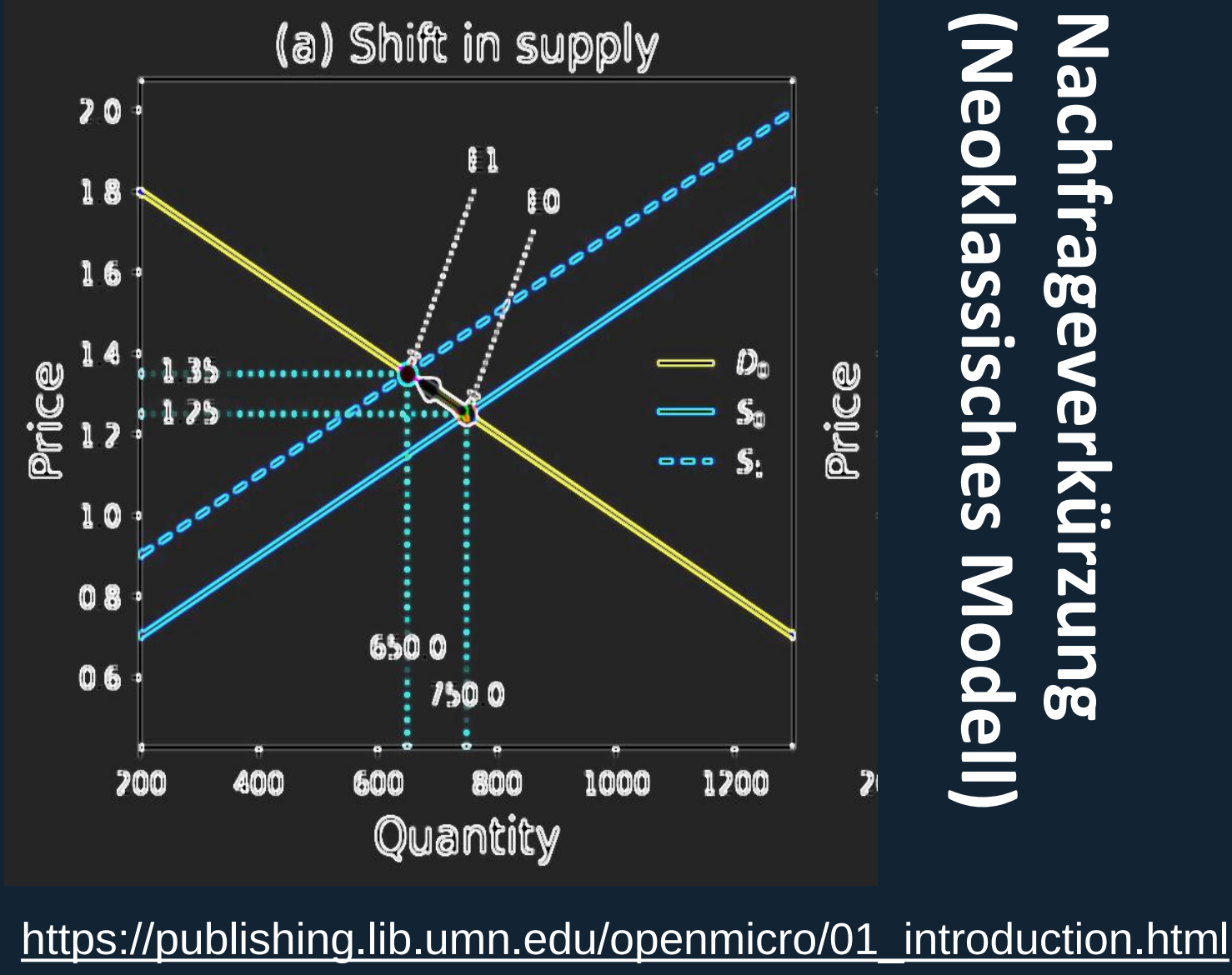
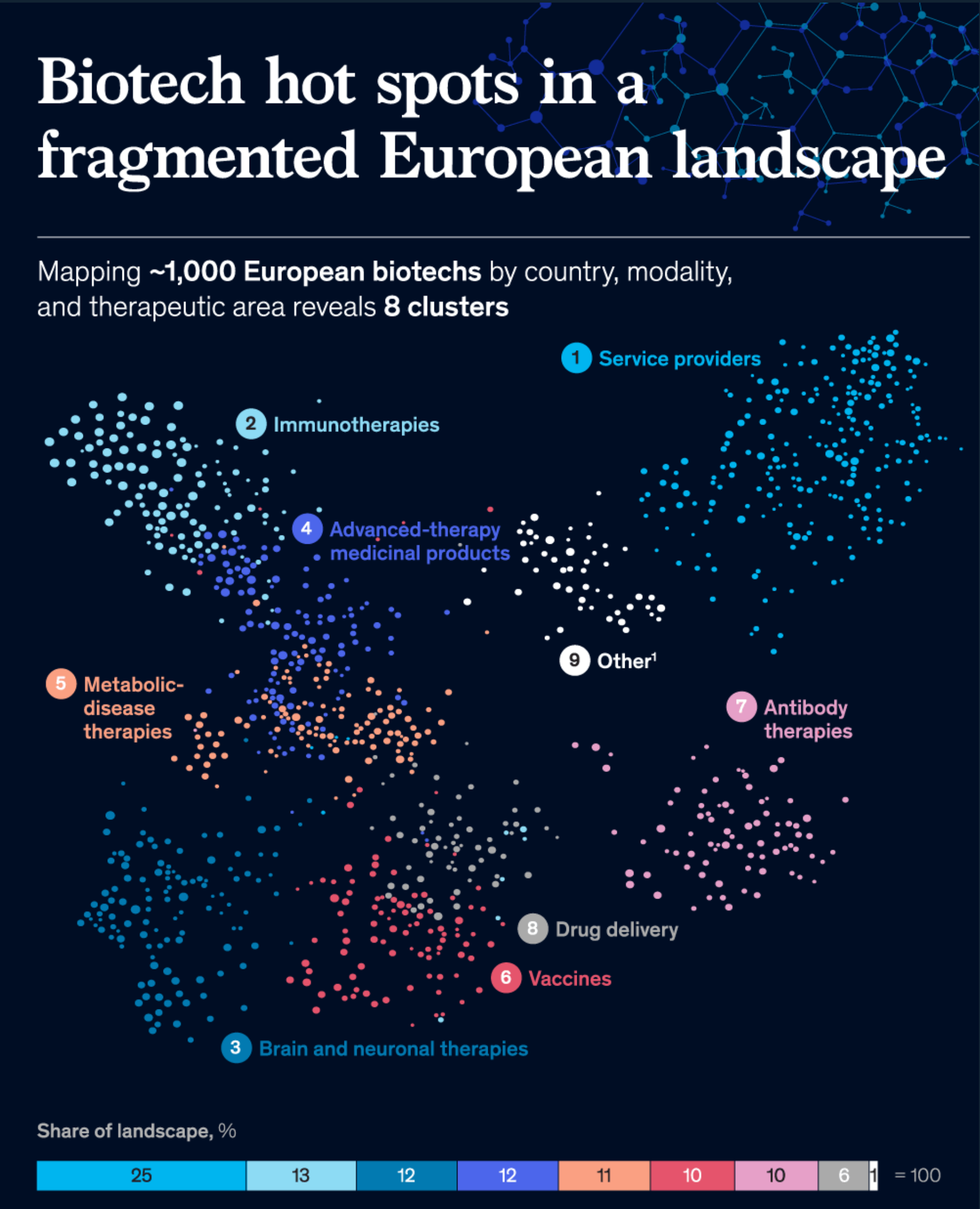
Wirtschaft & Bioentrepreneurship AG
